

Tell Doug Ford we do no want any cuts to public education

Talking points for District 16 Members when speaking with your MPP:

- Increasing the secondary class size average to 28:1 will mean less funding for our boards, which will force boards to pack more students into every class, this will mean fewer teachers available for our students
- We refuse to support any hiring freeze for teachers, ECEs or other school support staff
- No student should be forced to take an online course, it should be their choice. Our students learn differently and not all students have access to technology or high-speed internet at home
- It is unacceptable to make changes to the structure of autism service delivery that results in less access
- Demand the additional funding required to address the \$15.9 billion school repair backlog
- Cuts means less supports for mental health and well-being programs and initiatives
- Cuts to education mean fewer RESOURCES—less access to learning technology, closing of libraries and learning spaces, and the closing of community schools
- We refuse to support any further cuts to funding for our schools because we want protection of public education – access for everyone, opportunity for everyone, achievement for everyone and value for everyone
